



## Brantford Community Hockey League – Shoot Out Format

Below is the BCHL Shoot Out format, which is to be used to break tie games at the end of regulation. This policy is applicable to Championship play only or may be enforced at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

- Each team will submit a list of 3 shooters - **in a specified order** - to the timekeeper's bench at the start of the shoot-out round.
- Both teams will **shoot simultaneously**, from either side of the centre ice face-off circle on the ref's whistle.
- Team will get a point for each goal scored. The format is a 3-round shoot-out (3rd round is not necessary if the score is 2-0 after the first two rounds).
- The team with the most goals after 3 rounds wins the game.
- If the teams are tied after 3 rounds, then each coach will select one additional shooter per round (each team must use each player in their line-up, **before** any player can repeat as a shooter).
- Shoot out continues in a sudden death format, until one team wins a round.
